

There is no charge for the session




NEWS FROM ROMILEY METHODIST CHURCH

Dear Friends,

Once again the pattern of the year brings us the Annual Methodist Conference, this year between 29th June and 3rd July in Leeds. On Sunday 30th June, the Sunday morning service in many of our churches will involve a live streaming of the Conference Worship. It is always a joyful occasion with lively, vibrant worship and it's fantastic that the wonders of modern technology will allow the service to be shared in our local churches.

The Methodist Conference is the governing body of the Methodist Church under God. It has responsibility for the government, discipline, management and administration of the life of the Church. The Conference is also a place for worship, thanksgiving, celebration and Ordination. This year we are delighted that our own Deacon Janet Amey will be Ordained!

When a Minister has completed their training, there are two events which take place on the Sunday of the Conference. The 'Reception into Full Connexion' is a ceremony which takes place during the Conference Worship which says that it recognises the minister has successfully completed their training, including a period of Probation working in Circuit, and that we are proud for that person to enter into the service of God in the Methodist Church. Later on in the day, in a special service held in a church close to the Conference venue, each Minister is Ordained by the laying on of hands by an ex-President of the Conference and, in Janet's case, a Representative of the Diaconal Order.

The congregation are asked to proclaim, 'They are worthy!' and the Ministers are asked to declare their lifelong commitment to ministry. They make promises to accept the doctrines and discipline of the church, and to be faithful in worship, prayer and study. During the Ordination itself – which emphasises the calling of the individual by God rather than by the Church - the President asks God to send the Holy Spirit upon the person being ordained 'for the office and work of a minister in the Church.'

It's a beautiful ceremony and if any of you would like to be in Leeds for Janet's Ordination please let me know – there may be tickets still available.

In any case, I invite you to give thanks for Janet and her ministry in the United Stockport Circuit as she takes this big step. Please pray for her and all those who will be Received into Full Connexion and ordained on Sunday 30th June and for all the members of the Conference, as they gather to do the work of God.

Would you consider being a Circuit Steward?

The role of circuit steward is an important one in the life of the Methodist Church

The circuit is a key structure in Methodism. It is to circuits, not churches, that ministers are stationed and Methodism acknowledges that it is the circuit that is "the primary unit in which Local Churches express and experience their interconnexion in the Body of Christ, for purposes of mission, mutual encouragement and help"

Those who have taken on this responsibility point to how rewarding and stimulating it can be as they seek to support and shape the circuit in response to the needs and challenges of its local area.

Circuit stewards work in partnership with presbyters, deacons, church workers and others to enable individuals and communities to find fulfilment and belonging within the Church.

As the role is voluntary, circuit stewards carry out their responsibilities alongside jobs, family commitments and other responsibilities. So, patience and a sense of humour are essential criteria for the job, as is the ability to work positively together as a team.

In the United Stockport Circuit, the Circuit Stewards and the ministers meet as the Circuit Leadership Team at least once a month, usually in person but once every quarter on Zoom and have roles ranging from looking after manses to supporting ministers pastorally, overseeing ministerial invitations, and liaising with local churches. Learning is "on the job" and it is recognised that we all learn from each other. It is not necessary to be an "expert" but to offer your time for the benefit of the circuit as a whole.

If you think you might be able to offer yourself for the role of Circuit Steward, please speak to either of us, or to your minister – you are not committing to anything by having a conversation!



事情始於去年年底,因為經濟問題,我不得不四處尋找工作。為此,我不斷祈禱,希望上帝能引導 我找到一份合適的工作。直到十一月中旬,在朋友的介紹下,我受聘於一家酒店,主要負責清潔 房間。工作了一天後,我發現這份工作並不適合我。我想,我並不願意在這家酒店工作,因為我的 才能無法在此發揮。

到了工作的第二天,一位主內的弟兄告訴我有一個工作機會,內容主要是在一個音樂劇團裡妥善 照顧和組裝樂器,並需要出國到韓國和香港演出。我感到這是一個機會,是上帝為我指引的另一 條路。我知道自己並沒有相關資歷,只是一名樂手,但我依然將簡歷發給了公司。如果這是上帝 為我安排的機會,祂一定會成就的!經過與他們的溝通,他們決定聘用我。我既興奮又發現了許 多問題。公司沒有提供正式的僱傭合同,薪資發放時間也不明確,工作期間的保險安排也沒有詳 細說明。此外,他們表示已經在倫敦開始排練,需要我盡快前往倫敦,這讓我更需時間安排在倫 敦的住宿。

此時,我深刻地體會到自己確實願意做這份工作,不喜歡在酒店工作,但這條路充滿未知,風險 很大。幸運的是,我有一群弟兄姊妹的支持和幫助,他們花了一晚時間幫我列出一些問題,供我 向公司詢問。我感受到人類需要彼此的幫助,有時我們是脆弱的。最終,公司解答了這些問題,並 且有一位不太熟悉的朋友願意讓我在他家暫住一個月。於是,我感謝主,決定獨自一人去冒險。

在這份工作中,我絕對是在邊做邊學,沒有任何實習經驗就直接進入實戰。此外,許多韓國人並 不會說英語,這增加了工作的難度。但相比這些,我更感受到身處異地的孤獨,深刻理解了聖經 中"不可停止聚會"的重要性。不僅僅是基督徒,作為人類,我們需要一群志同道合的朋友,彼此 支持、鼓勵和糾正。

希望大家在這裡能共同建立友誼,一起學習神的話語,互相扶持與鼓勵,建立基督的身體。

Hong Kong Fellowship

HONG KONG FELLOWSHIP

Hello, I am a member of the Hong Kong Fellowship Group. My name is Sunny. I am honoured to be invited by Mei Yuk to share my personal experience here.


The story began at the end of last year when I had to look for work everywhere due to economic problems. I kept praying, hoping that God would lead me to find a suitable job. By mid-November, a friend introduced me to a job at a hotel, which mainly involved cleaning rooms. After one day, I realized this job wasn't suitable for me. I thought my talents couldn't be utilized there, and I didn't want to continue.

On the second day, a brother in Christ told me about a job opportunity involving the care and assembly of musical instruments in a music troupe, which also required traveling to South Korea and Hong Kong for performances. I felt this was an opportunity and another path given by God. Although I didn't have the relevant qualifications and was just a musician, I sent my resume to the company, believing that if it was God's will, it would happen. After communicating with them, they hired me. I was extremely excited but also realized there were many issues. The company didn't provide a concrete employment contract, clear salary payment schedules, or detailed insurance arrangements. Moreover, rehearsals had already started in London, and I needed to arrange accommodation there quickly.

At that moment, I deeply understood my willingness to do this job and my dislike for hotel work, but this path had too many unknowns and involved considerable risks. Fortunately, I had the support and help of my brothers and sisters, who helped me list questions to send to the company. I felt that as humans, we need others' help and are sometimes weak. In the end, the company answered those questions, and an acquaintance offered me a place to stay for a month. I thanked the Lord and decided to venture out on my own.

For this job, it was learning by doing, without any prior internship, and directly getting into actual work. Additionally, many Koreans did not speak English, which increased the job's difficulty. But beyond these matters, I felt the loneliness and fear of being in a foreign place, deeply understanding the importance of the Bible's teaching to "not give up meeting together." Not only as Christians but as humans, we need like -minded friends to support, encourage, and correct each other.

I hope everyone here can build friendships, learn God's word together, support and encourage each other, and build the body of Christ.
